The composting program at ÉCH has significantly reduced the amount of waste that goes into landfills. We also qualified for a Climate Action Grant of \$1000 to help support the program.

Weekly, a crew of responsible students led by Sarah and Erin collect plastics from the classroom to recycle. The Roots and Shoots team weighs the plastics to see how much they can collect and recycle at the school. We are excited about the environmental stewardship shown by our students.
