### SNOW REMOVAL AND SNOWFALL

Since joining École Cobble Hill, parents and staff have informed me that the road leading up to the school is treacherous when it snows. We investigated the priority for plowing, here is some information regarding snow removal. Both Dougan Drive and Learning Way are classified as "Class C" highways in our contract. Essentially, this means that these are our third priority when it comes to snow removal. I have posted a link below for more information about road classifications:

The crews and supervisors are very well versed in the routes/priorities in the Cobble Hill and Shawnigan Lake areas and do their best to maintain the school bus routes prior to buses running and school pick-up/drop-off times. In saying that, main highways (Class A) and secondary's (Class B) take priority in our contract with the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure, so depending on when a snowstorm starts or stops, this can impact the timing of our maintenance on the Class C routes.

The safety of our community is of the highest priority, please exercise good judgment when driving during days we have snowfall. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Mr. Zibin.

#### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

During the year, the school may be closed due to inclement weather. These announcements will be posted on the following media outlets: @CowichanSchools Facebook and Twitter accounts, Juice FM (89.7 FM), CBC Radio (90.5 FM), CFAX (1070 AM), The Zone (91.3 FM), The Q! (100.3 FM), CHEK News and Global BC will all be informed. Also, the Parents of École Cobble Hill Facebook Page. **The School District 79 Website will also be updated with a banner informing of closures.** 

#### **POWER OUTAGES**

In the event of a power outage schools are not closed. Usually, the power outage is solved in 2 hours or less. If more than 2 hours, the Principal or Vice-Principal will contact the Associate Superintendent for further direction. If the outage lasts for over two hours, the Superintendent will decide if students are sent home early or if parents/guardians are to be advised to come and pick up their children. <u>Students are not sent home from school unless authorized.</u>

In schools with elementary students, office staff contact all parents/guardians directly, before sending students home. It can take several hours to call ALL parents/guardians. All decisions related to calling parents/guardians to pick up students at school, or making announcements on the local radio station, or having busses go early, are made by the Superintendent, or designate. Any parents/guardians who want to take their children home can certainly do so. However, they should not be taking other children with them unless the school has received word from the custodial parent/guardian.
