SAFE ARRIVAL

To enhance our existing absence-checking procedures, we are introducing **a new**, student absence reporting system called **SafeArrival**. This system will reduce the time it takes to verify student attendance, make it easy for you to report your child's absence and easy for staff to respond to unexplained student absences.
